

Community Access Program:

Campability SA Community Access Programs are run Saturday and Sunday from 9am to 5pm.

We are also able to negotiate transport as required.

The program is designed to foster and develop life skills, social development, building resilience, strengthen and maintain relationships, physical activity and encourage participants to try new experiences in a friendly and caring environment.

Some examples of the types of activities we offer are:

- Attend recreation programs in the community.
- Daily living skills such as cooking, shopping, filling out forms, money handling.
- Public transport guidance and support.
- Creating creative and artistic skills through art & craft.
- Support to attend events of interest.
- Support with volunteering opportunities within the community.
- BBQs, picnic in the park.

We are also able to offer overnight accommodation and extended stay if required.



Day Option / Mentoring Program:

Campability SA Day Options Program provides centre-based support to participants living with a disability.

The program operates Monday to Friday and provides participants with the opportunity to participate in a range of programs tailored to meet their individual needs.

We aim to enhance participant's life skills, build friendships and provide opportunities to participate in activities within the community. We are also able negotiate transport as required.

Program includes:

- Life skills
- Vocational
- Social / Reactional



Short Stays

Campability SA Shorts stays are organised twice a month. Participants will be collected from their homes on Saturday morning and returned home approximately 5:00pm Sunday evening.

There are also opportunities for extended Short Stays they may commence from a Thursday or Friday to Sunday 5pm

Short Stays - include:

- Breakfast Sunday morning (or other mornings)
- Lunch all days
- Dinner Saturday evening (other evenings)
- activities

Each short stay is designed to provide participants with a wide variety of activities which are tailored to their individual needs, interests and abilities.

Our highly experienced staff will provide opportunities for each participant to enhance their social skills in an environment which will support life skills whilst developing resilience and confidence.

Short Stays will be held at various locations throughout SA. Participants and their families will receive notification of the location with a full list of what is required prior to the event.

Some examples of the activities we provide are:

Fishing. shopping –life skills, visiting animal parks, local historic venues, dining at restaurants, archery, boat cruises and more
